### SHED SAFETY RULES

- NO work is to be undertaken unless TWO (2) members are present at the Shed.  
**Members are permitted to use the power tools & machinery they have been certified on.**
- The Men's Shed is not a place for running businesses out of. The Men's Shed Association, & our sheds guides & expectations are... 1/3 of your work is for personal benefits, 1/3 for the shed running & maintenance & 1/3 for input into the wider community.
- All members are to take responsibility for the safety of themselves as well as others.
- Members shall be certified as competent on a machine before using that machine.
- A maximum of 2 people at a machine at any one time.
- Ear-muffs and safety glasses shall be worn when working on machines.
- Footwear shall be fully enclosed. (**NO** sandals or thongs at any time.)
- Long hair, below shoulder length shall be covered or tied in a ponytail especially when handling food.
- Fingernails shall be cut short to prevent catching timber or tools.
- No loose clothing or jewellery shall be worn whilst using tools or machines.
- Report any missing or damage to machines or tools to the co-ordinator of the day.
- Return all tools used during the day to their respective place.
- Return Resins and Inflammable materials to the respective dedicated locker storage. **No exceptions.**
- Borrowing of tools or books shall be at the discretion of the co-ordinator of the day. Certain tools shall **NOT** leave the Shed. An entry shall be recorded in the items borrowed book in the tool room. Upon return an entry shall confirm.
- Clean up after you have finished on a machine or project.
- All benches are to be left clean and free of work at the end of each day. Small projects are to be placed in shelves. The exceptions are glued or resin jobs that are being worked on the next day.
- Children who attend the shed with a member shall be accompanied by that Member at ALL times.
- Clean up machinery after use putting all tools away for others to use.
- All work to be stored on the shelves provided clearly marked with your name.  
**Any animals belonging to members or visitors shall be on a leash and kept outside at ALL times.**
